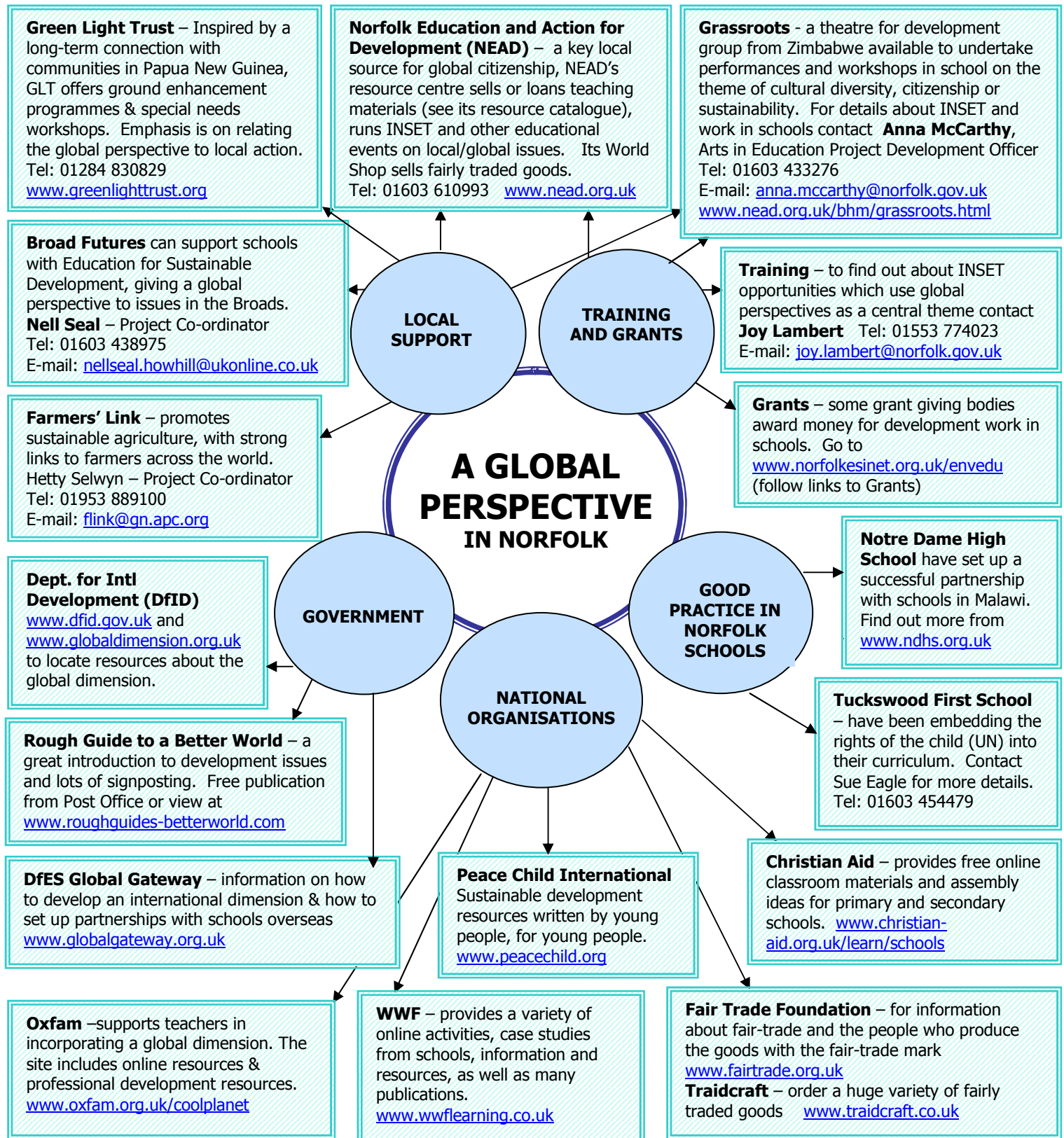


BRINGING A GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE TO YOUR SCHOOL LIFE
